Charleston County Public Works invites the public to learn more about the Better North Bridge project at a public information meeting on **Wednesday, December 15**, from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. at The Lowcountry Food Bank located at 2864 Azalea Dr., North Charleston 29405. The meeting will also be available online from **December 15, 2021 to January 29, 2022**.

The purpose of the public meeting is to offer information on the project's development process, outline the criteria used to evaluate the proposed alternatives, gather public comments, and provide next steps.
